Euro Media Group has developed expertise in broadcast TV images in 3D, equipping some of its mobile video trucks with the necessary recording and broadcasting equipment. Up until now, the specialised 3D equipment has been installed gradually in the existing recording trucks.

In order to increase productivity while also reducing installation times, Euro Media France has developed a new strategy and will soon offer a separate 3D stereo unit. Thanks to this approach, the production team will be able to work as usual in a HD OB truck, which will be equipped with a 3D monitoring system. The 3D work will thus be carried out in a different unit, without disturbing the normal recording process.
